ECOvanta is dedicated to safe and environmentally responsible operations. In addition to the rigorous standards of our corporate environmental, health and safety policies, we are committed to the following principles for our electronic waste recycling business:

- We will maximize the asset recovery and recycling rates we offer to our customers and partners.
- We will operate our business and manage e-Waste, Focus and Hazardous e-Waste (HEW) materials throughout the recycling chain in a manner that is protective of human health and the environment.
- We will adhere to, and partner with downstream vendors who adhere to, the reuse, refurbish, recover, and then dispose hierarchy for the management of used and end-of-life electronic equipment.
- We will only do business with third parties who are committed to best practices in preventing violations of the rules and decisions of the Basil Convention, OECD, and national laws pertaining to exporting, importing, or transporting Focus and HEW materials.
- We will operate as good corporate citizens and stewards for sustainability within the communities we operate and service.
- We will discourage the use of child and prison labor for processing e-Waste throughout the recycling chain.
- We will address our customers' data security and privacy requirements through the secure destruction of hard drives and other data storage media and make information available on the security risks associated with the improper handling of e-Waste.
- We will make this policy available to the public and communicate and reinforce it to our employees, customers and partners.
- ECOvanta is committed to be an industry leader in e-Waste recycling by achieving superior awareness and performance through a process of monitoring, rigorous evaluation and continuous improvement.
